

## Opis choroby \*

### Definicja

A rare acquired skeletal muscle disease characterized by inflammation of a muscle due to infection with a fungus, usually occurring in an immunocompromised host. General symptoms are pain, tenderness, swelling, and/or weakness in the affected muscle. Most common causative agent are *Candida* species, with myositis developing in the setting of systemic candidiasis, typically as diffuse, multiple microabscesses. Other fungal pathogens potentially causing myositis are *Cryptococcus neoformans*, *Histoplasma capsulatum*, *Coccidioides* species, or *Aspergillus* species, among others.
