## Definicja

A very rare Epstein-Barr virus-associated lymphoproliferative disorder characterized by a chronic, recurrent, vesiculopapular rash, which subsequently ulcerates and scars, located mainly on sunexposed areas and which is associated with systemic manifestations, such as fever, weight loss, asthenia, facial edema, arthralgia, lymphadenopathy, hepatosplenomegaly and/or increased liver enzymes. Hypersensitivity to mosquito bites has been associated and an increased risk of developing systemic lymphoma has been reported.
