

## Opis choroby \*

### Definicja

A rare epithelial tumour of stomach, defined histopathologically as keratinizing cell masses with pearl formation, mosaic pattern of cell arrangement, intercellular bridges, and high concentrations of sulphhydryl or disulphide bonds, arising directly from gastric mucosa, without esophageal involvement. It is characterized by preferential location in the upper third of the stomach, high probability of lymphovascular and serosal invasion and late onset of clinical symptoms associated with poor prognosis including nonspecific symptoms of abdominal pain, dysphagia, vomiting, melena or hematochezia, haematemesis and weight loss.
