Definicja

Hydatidosis or cyst hydatid disease is a cosmopolitan larval cestodosis caused principally by the *Echinococcus granulosus* tapeworm, the adult form of which parasitises the intestine of dogs. Hydatidosis generally affects large domestic herbivores; humans are dead-end hosts, infected through contact with herding dogs or through ingestion of food contaminated with canine excrement.
