Familial atrial fibrillation is a rare, genetically heterogenous cardiac disease characterized by erratic activation of the atria with an irregular ventricular response, in various members of a single family. It may be asymptomatic or associated with palpitations, dyspnea and lightheadedness. Concomitant rhythm disorders and cardiomyopathies are frequently reported.
