

## **Opis choroby \***

### Definicja

Familial partial lipodystrophy, Kőbberling type, is a very rare form of familial partial lipodystrophy (FPLD; see this term) of unknown etiology characterized by lipoatrophy that is confined to the limbs and a normal or increased fat distribution of the face, neck, and trunk. Arterial hypertension and diabetes have also been associated. Inheritance is thought to be autosomal dominant.
