

## Opis choroby \*

### Definicja

A rare palpebral disorder characterized by recurrent episodes of painless eyelid edema. It usually occurs bilaterally, typically affects the upper eyelids, and may manifest as a hypertrophic form resulting in orbital fat herniation through a weakened orbital septum, or an atrophic form with atrophy of redundant eyelid skin and superior nasal fat pads. Additional findings are formation of pseudoepicanthal folds, lacrimal gland prolapse, or ptosis.
