Crouzon syndrome with acanthosis nigricans (CAN) is a very rare, clinically heterogeneous form of faciocrianiostenosis with Crouzon-like features and premature synostosis of cranial sutures (Crouzon disease, see this term), associated with acanthosis nigricans (AN; see this term).
