Definicja

Rare form of salmonellosis is a group of rare invasive salmonellosis that includes infection with *Salmonella enterica* typhoidal species (*S.* typhi and *S.* paratyphi) that results in enteric fever, and infection by invasive non-typhoidal species (typically strains of *S.* typhimurium and *S.* enteritidis) which have a high burden amongst immunocompromised or malnourished individuals, and results in bacteremia, systemic febrile disease, and variable manifestations including lower respiratory tract infection and splenomegaly.
