### Definicja

Rare form of salmonellosis is a group of rare invasive salmonellosis that includes infection with *Salmonella enterica* typhoidal species (*S. typhi* and *S. paratyphi*) that results in enteric fever, and infection by invasive non-typhoidal species (typically strains of *S. typhimurium* and *S. enteritidis*) which have a high burden amongst immunocompromised or malnourished individuals, and results in bacteremia, systemic febrile disease, and variable manifestations including lower respiratory tract infection and splenomegaly.
