### Definicja

Dedifferentiated liposarcoma (DDL) is a high-grade subtype of liposarcoma (LS; see this term) that progresses from well-differentiated liposarcoma (WDL; see this term), and most often occurs in the retroperitoneum. It is defined as a region of nonlipogenic sarcoma associated with WDL. .
